## From the Law Book

Rule 27. Dead Bowl

A dead bowl is a dead bowl if it is not a toucher and comes to rest in the ditch;

It is not a toucher and rebounds onto the rink after contact with the face of the bank or with the jack or a toucher in the ditch;

As a result of play it comes to rest less that 14 metres, as measured in a straight line from the centre of the mat line to the nearest point of the bowl;

It passes completely outside the boundaries of the rink of play after being moved as a result of play; In its original course it passes outside a boundary of the rink on a bias which would prevent it from reentering the rink of play.
